### What You Know About Delta-8 THC

This course covers changes made in the 2018 farm bill that relaxed oversight of hemp production, what forms delta-8 can be found in, the psychoactive effects of delta-8 and the legality of delta-8 when extracted from hemp and cannabis.

Kratom: The New Drug Substitute, provides officers with general knowledge of Kratom, its psychoactive alkaloids and provides impairment indicators observed when three Kratom consumers completed drug influence evaluations.

Ryan Hutton is a full-time law enforcement officer for the state of Missouri. He created Extract-ED Training, which provides training to law enforcement, prosecutors, and civilian entities on a variety of topics, including marijuana, drug trends, drug impairment, officer wellness, and leadership. He has given presentations on drug impairment for the Missouri Office of Prosecution Services, the Colorado District Attorneys Council, the New Hampshire Office of Highway Safety, the Florida Coalition for Highway Safety, the National Life Savers Conference, and the International Associations of Chiefs of Police Impaired Driving Traffic Safety Conference. He is the lead Legal Marijuana instructor for the state of Missouri, Missouri Office of Prosecution Services, University of Central Missouri, and Missouri Southern State University. He was awarded Officer of the Year in 2013 by Mothers Against Drunk Driving and Trooper of the Year in 2017, by the Law Enforcement Traffic Safety Advisory Council.
